Only students that were approved at the end of school last year will start this year with their breakfast/lunch status from last year. If your student is new to Lee County or was not approved at the end of school last year, they must bring money for breakfast/lunch until their application is processed.</p> <p>On the first day of school each student will receive an application with directions for completing the form. The student's parents/guardians must report the income of each individual living in the household and return the form to the student's school. If you have more than one student in the School District, you only need to fill out one application per family. Filling out multiple applications for a family only increases the numbers of applications which will need to be processed.</p> <p>Blank meal applications in English and Spanish will continue to be available at the schools. Instructions for completing an English application by our Creole applicants are available in the main office of your child's school. The School District of Lee County receives over 42,000 meal applications at the start of each school year. In an effort to expedite the processing of these forms, the District will continue using an automated process this year.
